Tor Vergata University in the main International rankings

Tor Vergata University of Rome is one of the top Public universities in Rome, Italy. It is ranked 494th among all the best universities in the world after two consecutive years in the range position 511-520 (**QS Global World Rankings 2022**).

Based on the **Times Higher Education World Ranking-THE**, Tor Vergata University of Rome climbs from the "401-500" range (THE 2021) to the "301-350" range (THE 2022), among 1622 universities and it is ranked at the 7th position among the 51 Italian Universities classified.

Furthermore in the **Times Higher Education (Top 50 Universities in the World under 50)** Tor Vergata University is ranked 68th and at the 2nd position among the Italian Universities.

International Agreements

University of Rome Tor Vergata has several joint research programs and more than 500 bilateral agreements with Partner Universities all over the world. This

implies excellent Erasmus+ opportunities, Overseas studying abroad scholarships for undergraduate and graduate students and joint research opportunities.

Startup Incubator

The University of Rome Tor Vergata started an ongoing dialogue with institutions and businesses, offering support to the creation and development of innovative enterprises. Tor Vergata has a Startup Incubator, which is free and aimed at students wanting to start or grow entrepreneur-driven ventures.

The Italian university system

The Italian university system is based on three cycles, according to the "Bologna Process" which ensures comparability in the standard and quality of higher education qualifications among European HE Institutions,

- **Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science (Bachelor Degree)** – B.A./B.Sc. – duration 3 years – 180 ECTS
- **Master of Arts or Master of Science** – M.A. /M. Sc. – duration 2 years – 120 ECTS
- **One –cycle Degree** – Undergraduate M.A./M.Sc. – duration 5/6 years – 300/360 ECTS
- **Doctoral degree** – PhD – duration 3 years

The system also offers other post-graduate course (typically 1 years, 60 ECTS):

- **First Level Specialising Master** (access with B.A./B.Sc.)
- **Second Level Specialising Master** (access with M.A./M.Sc. or Undergraduate M.A./M.Sc.)
- **Post-Graduate Training Course** (so called "Corsi di Perfezionamento", for access please contact the course staff)
- **Specialization School** (access with M.A./ M.Sc. or Undergraduate M.A./M.Sc.)
