C. Pedagogical project

The BIP will be devoted to:

(i) Presentation of their research projects by doctoral participants.

The participating doctoral or advanced master students who wish to do so may present a paper related to their doctoral research project (20-25 minutes), and each presentation will be followed by remarks prepared in advance by another doctoral student (10-15 minutes) and by a discussion (30-35) minutes (total: 110 minutes).

2. Funding and scholarships

The project is founded by ERASMUS+ and students from the University of Rome Tor Vergata will have a scholarship to cover the costs related to the short-term physical mobility. All the students enrolled in a PhD for the academic year 2022-2023 are eligible for the scholarship. Scholarships will cover the travel tickets and students will have a fixed amount of payment for each of the 5 days of stay in Vechta for covering the accommodation cost.
