G.W.F. Hegel: Introductory Lectures on Aesthetics

We will also invite a few keynote speakers to deliver papers related to the topics and the two classics.

## 2. Funding and scholarships

The project is funded by ERASMUS+ and students from the University of Rome Tor Vergata will have a scholarship to cover the costs related to the short-term physical mobility.

All the students enrolled in a PhD for the academic year 2023-2024 are eligible for the scholarship.

Scholarships will cover the travel tickets and students will have a fixed amount of payment for each of the 5 days of stay in Vechta for covering the accommodation cost.
