

Privacy notice pursuant to articles 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR") regarding the processing of personal data of students and hosts in the context of the Housing Project "Together We Are Better"

2. Categories of personal data	<p>The University shall process the following data of students and hosts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - personal data (name, surname, nationality, gender and age); - contact information (phone number, mobile number and email address); - residential data (city and residential address); - languages spoken; - employment status; - habits and personal interests.
3. Source of personal data	Personal data is provided directly by the Data Subject when registering on the platform of the Housing Project "Together We Are Better".
4. Purposes of data processing and legal basis	<p>Data is processed within the framework of the Housing Project "Together We Are Better". Specifically, data collected during registration shall be used to pair students with hosts, to facilitate and monitor their cohabitation.</p> <p>The legal basis for processing is article 6(1)(a) "<i>the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes</i>".</p> <p>Consent is provided by ticking the appropriate box during registration and can be revoked at any time by emailing privacy@uniroma2.it.</p> <p>The Data Controller does not use automated processes for profiling purposes.</p>
5. Categories of recipients of personal data	Data shall be processed by University staff and collaborators, in their capacity as Data Processing Officers and/or third parties expressly appointed as Data Processors, pursuant to article 28 of the GDPR.
6. Data retention period	Collected data shall be retained for two years after the cohabitation period ends.
7. Rights of the Data Subject	<p>The Data Subject has the right to obtain from the Data Controller, (by writing to privacy@uniroma2.it) access, rectification, deletion of the personal data, as well as the right of limitation, of portability of the data and opposition to processing concerning him/her (articles 15-21 of the GDPR).</p> <p>The Data Subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the Garante Per La Protezione Dei Dati Personali (protocollo@gpdp.it or protocollo@pec.gpdp.it) (article 77 of the GDPR).</p>
8. Obligation to provide personal data	Providing personal data is necessary for the purposes outlined in Section 4.
9. Data processing methods	Personal data shall be processed using both paper-based and electronic tools with appropriate security measures in place.
10. Transfer of personal data to non-EU countries	Personal data collected shall not be transferred to third Countries or international organizations.
