ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

“IUPALS Project – Italian Universities for Palestinian Students”

Reference: Article 9, Page 5 of the “Call for Applications for the Awarding of Two Scholarships to Palestinian Students Residing in the Palestinian Territories Enrolling in the 2025/2026 Academic Year in a Degree Programme Offered by the University”

(Decree No. 1607/2025 dated 08/05/2025)

As outlined in Article 9, “Italian Language Courses”, on page 5 of the above call for application (Decree No. 1607/2025 dated 08/05/2025), please be informed that the CRUI published a specific notice, which is also available on the CRUI webpage for the [IUPALS Calls for Applications](#) and should be read carefully.

In particular, the CRUI notice regarding the **Italian Language Courses provided under the IUPALS Project** includes the following details:

- Before the start of academic courses in Italy, students will participate in a specially organised Italian language course as part of the project. The course will run for five months, from June to October 2025, and will be held in Bethlehem and Ramallah at the Terra Sancta Schools.
Upon successful completion, students will receive a certificate detailing the course content and the skills they have acquired.
- Enrollment for the Italian language course must be completed by **May 23, 2025**, via the dedicated online registration form available here: <https://forms.gle/2MrnFx7wqfEUg1fB8>
- Students are required to attend and successfully complete the Italian language course offered through the project. The course will begin on **June 3, 2025**, and conclude on **October 23, 2025**.
To obtain the certificate of participation, students must attend at least 70% of the lessons.
The course schedule includes:
 - 24 hours per month of synchronous (live) instruction
 - 24 hours per month of asynchronous (self-paced) learning activities
