



**Privacy Notice pursuant to article 13 of Regulation EU 2016/679
("GDPR") for the purpose of registration for participation in events
organized by the University**

1. 2. Categories of personal data and data subjects	The University processes name, surname, contact information (email and telephone number) and body of belonging of those who register for events.
3. How we collect information	Personal data are collected directly from the data subject at the time of registration.
4. Purposes and legal basis of data processing	The personal data are processed for the purpose of registration for participation in events organized by the University. The legal basis is article 6, paragraph 1, letter e), of the GDPR, as the processing is necessary for the performance of institutional tasks concerning the so-called "third mission" (Legislative Decree 19/2012 as amended and Ministerial Decree 47/2013). The Data Controller does not use automatic processes aimed at profiling the data subject.
5. Categories of recipients who may receive your personal data	The data will be processed by the staff and collaborators of the University, in their capacity as persons authorised to process and/or by third parties expressly appointed as data processors, pursuant to article 28 of the GDPR.
6. Data retention period	Personal data subject to this processing will be kept for a period not exceeding 60 days after the conclusion of the event in which you attend following registration.
7. Rights of the data subjects	The data subject has the right to obtain from the Controller, (by writing to privacy@uniroma2.it) access to personal data, rectification or deletion of the same, the restriction of the processing concerning him/her or to object to the processing, as well as the right of portability (articles 15-21 of the GDPR). The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the Garante Per La Protezione Dei Dati Personali (protocollo@gpdp.it or protocollo@pec.gpdp.it) (article 77 of GDPR).
8. Obligation to provide personal data	Data provision is essential for the purpose of registration for participation in events. Failure to provide the data precludes the participation.
9. Data processing methods	Personal data are processed by automated means by the University staff, who is authorized to data processing according to their tasks, in respect of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, accuracy, relevance and necessity pursuant to article 5, paragraph 1, of the GDPR.
10. Transfer of personal data to non-EU countries	Personal data shall not be transferred to third countries and/or international organizations.
